



**Jaguar Class** – This half-term our topic is “Remembering” which will connect with Remembrance Day and the history of Carleton Rode Village and the school itself. This also connects with literacy as we retell events.

Computing – Using our new IPADS, we will be learning about programming using the *Scratch* programming tool. We will also do a reminder about safety on-line.

History – We are learning about the history of the school, the church and the local area, for example, looking at the footpaths in the area, those in the village that died in the war so that children understand the impact that the war may have had.

Music – Having learnt about pitch and duration and composed some very simple pieces of music, we will now further develop our composition skills using a piece of contemporary music as inspiration.

Science – This will be about Earth and Space in particular examining the movement of the Earth and other planets, the Sun and Moon. We will be gaining understanding of the Earth’s rotation to explain day and night.

In Literacy we will be focusing on recounts – how they are a form of story-telling but based on real life events. We give recounts every day verbally to our friends and family without even thinking about it. How do we make these interesting? We will look at how recounts differ depending on our audience in terms of detail and formality of language, and learn to write recounts in a newspaper format. We will also study a short film, “The Piano” by Aidan Gibbons, where a soldier looks back at his life. We will look at how the film communicates and how it conveys emotions through visuals and choice of music.

PSHE –We will be continuing to talk about Learning Behaviours. We talked in particular about independence last half –term. Now we have our Learning Behaviour “Aliens” we will further refer to these to help develop life-long learning behaviours. To support this, we are also finding out about how the brain works in Science lessons.

R.E. – Continuing from last half term - How do the beliefs of a Hindu impact their lives? – we will focus on Ghandi and how his beliefs influenced his life and the world.
