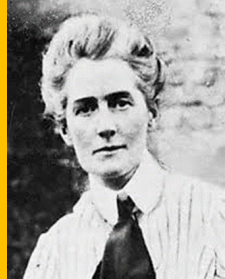
On Mondays and Wednesdays in PE they will be working on their Gymnastic skills.
