Early Years and Foundation Stage.

Children will do much of their learning through exploring, active learning and thinking critically. The key areas for their develop are:

- Personal, Social and emotional development
- Communication and Language
- Physical development
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design.

Children will have the opportunity to follow their own interests with learning planned and adapted to ensure this happens. The curriculum points below show the areas that KS1 will be focusing on therefore EYFS will have access to all this just taught in a less formal way.

Design Technology

The children will follow the design process making purposeful changes to their ideas to create a functional and appealing product.

Phonics

The year will start with the children learning to say and recognise phonic sounds. Writing will concentrate on early mark making and developing their fine motor skills through various media.

Mathematics

Maths will be taught using a variety of concrete objects with the purpose of giving the children a conceptual understanding of both Number. As the term progressing we will be developing our problem solving and reasoning.

Music

The children will be using their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.

Computing

The children will be working with simple algorithms to write instructions using both computers and robots. They will debug (change) their programs to make them more accurate.

We will then learn about using technology safely and respectfully.

Science will focus on Animals including Humans. The children will consider how we know things are alive and the basic needs of living things. They will also learn about their own bodies.
