

Jaguar Class – This half-term our topic is **How to run a business.**

Note for Year 6s: SATs are on Monday 8th to Thursday 11th.

There is a reading comprehension, grammar and punctuation and spelling paper, and three maths papers. There is no writing exam – this is an ongoing assessment based on class work. You are all well prepared so there is no need to worry about these. If pupils or parents have any questions, do just come and ask!

Maths – Our key focus will be 1) measure including time and 2) statistics looking at recording data and interpreting data across a range of contexts and pictorial representation.

Art – On Friday afternoons they will be working on their arts award log books and projects and setting up and running the art exhibition as a business/enterprise. This will include gathering and choosing work to frame and display, cataloguing, pricing, advertising and manning the event.

Literacy – Last half-term we looked at explanations with a particular focus on “why” something had happened. We will be using and applying that knowledge of explanation texts but looking more at the “how” something happens and using this skill in a science context.

We will then have a poetry week that will support widening our vocabulary and then look at a story writing, building on work from last term: describing a setting to create atmosphere and “show not tell” approach to describing a character. We will build in work on pace and suspense.

R.E. – The first key question this half term is “What can we learn about God from sacred texts?” This will be looking across faiths. Then they will consider ‘How can one person inspire many?’, again looking at across faiths.

Music – We have music experts coming into school – most of the sessions will be taken by ex-head of Norfolk Music, Maureen Hanke. The teaching will cover a range of musical skills and awareness and will include using this musicality through singing.

Science – We will be building on our investigation skills and learning how to record data and findings and how to write up our experiments. We will revisit science topics such as electricity and the human body .and digestive system.

Computing – The class will develop their awareness of the use of the internet and of websites as a tool to promote your business. They will assess other people’s websites and will develop their own to support the set up of a business.

P.E – P.E. is on Monday and Tuesday but please make sure that children have their P.E. kits in school all week in case this changes occasionally.
