

PE & Sports Grant Action Plan 2017/18

In the financial year 2017/18 Carleton Rode School will receive £13,027 in additional funding for PE & Sports, it will be spent in the following way:

Activity or Resource	Cost	Impact
Trip to Wimbledon for Tennis, includes tickets, transport, parking and staffing	£700	Enabling children to visit and experience extraordinary activities in sport and help develop children's ambition.
Afterschool sports clubs, 1 afterschool club a week all year	£1200	Providing children with opportunities to take part in activities which they may not otherwise be able to at no cost to parents / carers.
Equipment to improve current sports and add new sports this year's improvements in Golf and Ball sports	£3000	Providing opportunities for children to experience new and more diverse sports.
Cluster sports co-ordinator	£1000	Organisation of interschool sports competitions. Children can compete with their peers and talented children have opportunities for extension.
Travel to sports events, including cluster rounders, multiskills, cross country, etc	£1730	Interschool competitions and events including cross country, multiskills, rounders, football, netball and rugby.
Sports specialist teachers	£1000	Improvements to staff knowledge and skills for ongoing CPD in PE & Sports to ensure future sports are well run and to offer enrichment days.
An additional £4397 will be carried forward to next year as part funding for a large piece of playground equipment.
