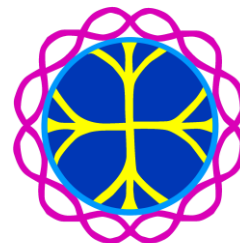

Census Day Thursday 4th October and School Funding

Please can we ask that all children who are eligible for Free School Meals, whether Universal (in Tiger Class) or not, please have a school lunch on Thursday 4th October (Census Day). Also, if you believe that your child may be entitled to Free School Meals based on family income and benefits, even if your child is in Tiger Class please complete an application form (available from Mrs Brosnihan in the school office) as the school receive additional funding for these children.
