

**Literacy** – We will

- Create a leaflet promoting a place to visit, looking at persuasiveness in language and visuals.
- Participate in debates, preparing our thoughts and arguments, practising these verbally and thinking how we need to consider other points of view. This will prepare for writing a balanced debate next half term.

**PSHE** – We will be looking at British Values including

- Democracy
- How this works in Britain: House of Commons; Parliament and the Judiciary.
- Rules, rights and responsibilities

We will run a mock trial to fully explore these areas.



**R.E.** – The question this half term is “How can following God bring freedom and justice?” This will look at some key people from the bible with a focus on Moses.

In French we will be naming parts of the body, learning how to describe somebody eg green eyes, and learning how to say you are ill.

**Art** – the skills covered will be colour mixing and matching; creating tones and shades; and understanding contrasting and complementary colours. These skills will be then used and applied with close observation and nature studies.

**Jaguar Class** –The topic is **Viewpoints** – both in terms of different opinions, different perspectives driven by culture, gender and age and geographical viewpoints.

**SATs are week commencing 13<sup>th</sup> May – we like to keep these low-key and to stress that these are not the child’s exams to “pass”; they are for school accountability. But do please ensure they get to bed on time the night before!**

**The writing for SATs is assessed at the end of July and we keep the children progressing in their maths and reading throughout the summer term. So the hard work continues...**

**Computing** – We will look at the development of technology, how to use search-engines effectively, and then we will begin coding starting with “Scratch”. This will continue into next half term.

**Maths** – The key focus this half term will be Position and Direction, Statistics, Algebra and Time. Please continue to support your child in learning their times tables.

**P.E.** will be Athletics on Tuesday and Tennis on Friday. Please can children have their P.E. kits with them every day in case of a temporary, last minute change in the time table.
