

English – In English this half term, we will look at how to write instructions. We will also look at fairy tales and other traditional stories, and have a go at writing some new versions of our own. We will use a variety of texts within our Guided reading sessions and will continue improving our spelling, punctuation and handwriting.

Maths – This half term we will continue to practise what we have previously learned, and will be doing more work on fractions. We will also learn about measurement. We will use reasoning and problem solving activities to further our learning. We will also continue to work on our times tables, having weekly tests

P.E – As well as our usual P.E on a Friday, (but please make sure the children have kits in school all week.) we will also have swimming each Thursday morning.

Art – To link with our topic 'Where We Live' we will be using our local area to inspire our art work. We will be focusing on the school and the church and use them to practise techniques in creating collages and other landscapes as well as designing our own stained glass window inspired by our church.

R.E – Within our R.E lessons, we will be exploring how people express their faith.

History – To link with our topic, we will learn about local history, and important people who came from our local area.

Geography - We are going to use fieldwork to look at physical and human features in the local area, which will fit nicely with our topic. We will learn about different aspects of human geography, and learn how to use a compass, and read maps.
