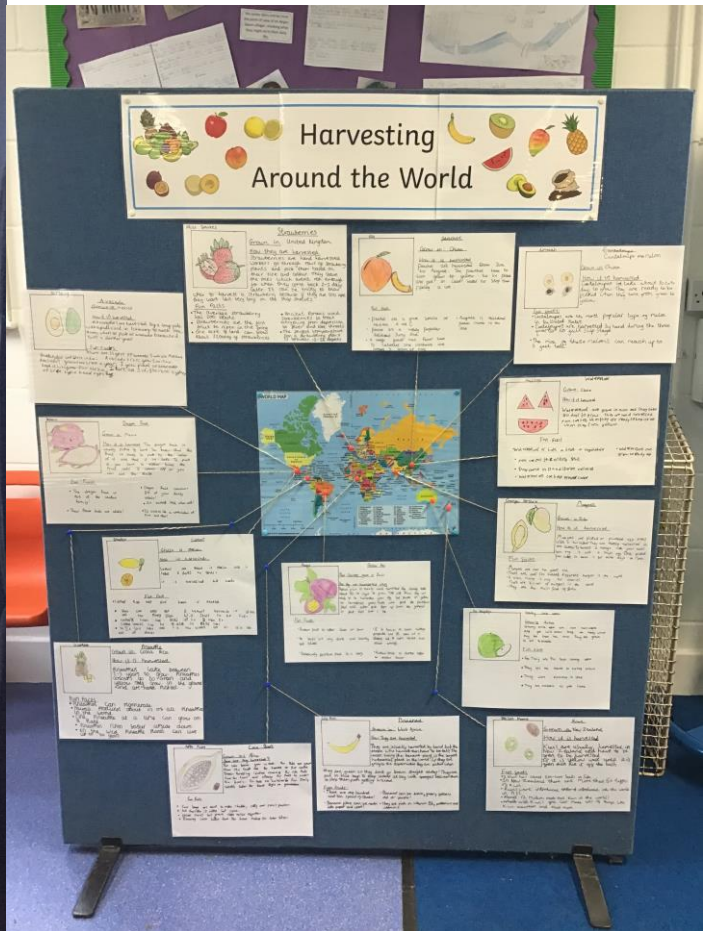
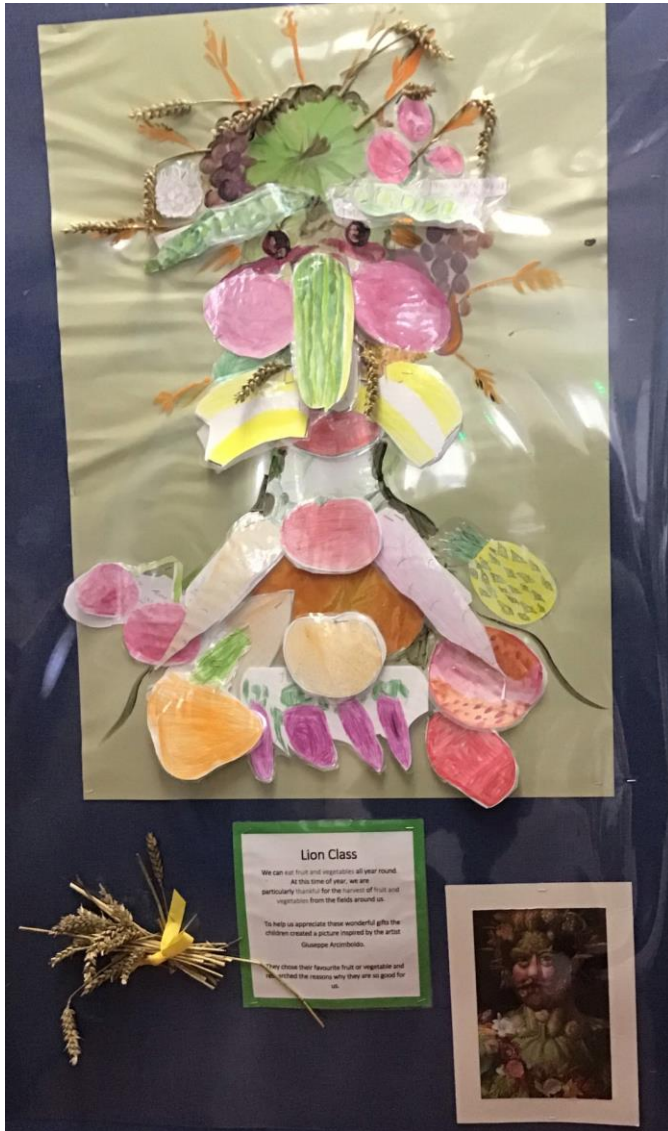


There are no set prices for the items so please donate what you wish.
